

Judo Australia is continuing to develop the 4-tiered Coach Accreditation Framework (CAF) to best deliver effective coach development and extended pathways for Judo coaches in Australia.

The CAF 1.0 replaced the previous NCAS as per the Australian Sports Commission requirements. The CAF 2.0 course requirements for Judo Coaches more closely aligns to the ASC modern approach principles.

CAF 2.0 maintains the 4 program levels, with the first three levels shifting to a more general coaching model. Senior Coaches will then be offered an opportunity to specialise in a particular area/s of Judo of interest gaining an Advanced Certificate offered by Judo Australia.

Importantly, JA will no longer require long-term coaches to complete the same certification every four years, rather moving to a new model of reoccurring & refresher level requirements.



PROPOSED JA COACHING PATHWAY

A STEP CHANGE - ONGOING DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES

The newly proposed CAF program 2.0 is designed for coaches at all levels to be exposed to new learning and development opportunities, rather than repeating the same on-line courses every 4 years.

Importantly, refresher courses are being introduced so experienced coaches do not have to keep repeating the same "initial" on-line courses they would have done 4 years previously. Providing greater opportunity to 're-accredit' through new, varied and more relevant content.

To further strengthen our JA Coaching Pathway, The Australian Sports Commission, Sports Integrity Australia and the Play by the Rules have valuable on-line teaching resources. Judo Australia will expand the exposure and leverage this content for our new and existing Judo Coaches at all levels, so they can benefit from the ASC modern approach principles.

ASSISTANT COACH ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS

INITIAL

+18 years - Child Protection Clearance* 15-17 years - Parental permission*

Senior Green Belt

HEORY

ASC Essential Coaching Skills -First 3 of 7 modules. (Online)*

Play by the Rules - Introduction to the Integrity of Sport Course (Mini). (Online)*

2 Certificates required

RE-OCCURING

+18 years - Child Protection Clearance* 15-17 years - Parental permission*

REFRESHER

No refresher on-line courses required, because Assistant Coaches will be encouraged and required to progress to Sensei Coaches after 4 years.

Minimum 30 classes over a 6 month period (Average 1 class per week).

30 lessons should include

- 25 Shadow Club Coach
- 5 lead coach

Recommendation in writing by Club Coach to JA for endorsement at completion of all elements. Minimum 30 classes over a 12 month period

ADVANCED COACH - PERFORMANCE JUDO ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS (EXAMPLE ONLY)

INITIAL

Must be a Senior Coach Accreditation (Current)

Minimum 24yrs of age.

Minimum 2nd Dan

Endorsed by State Organisation.

Current State Coach

Willingness to complete IJF Instructors Course within 2 years.

RE-OCCURING

+24 years - Child Protection Clearance

First Aid Certificate including CPR

REFRESHER

Complete 1 of the following.

RACTICAL

Attend 1 day (minimum) Practical Session hosted by JA.

Hosted on a yearly basis with attendance expected each year.
